Kevin Beauregard has held the position of Asst. Deputy Labor Commissioner/Asst. Director of the North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health Division (OSHNC), since 1999. Over the past 20 years, Kevin has also held positions as safety compliance supervisor, and safety compliance officer for the OSH Division. Additionally, he worked as a safety compliance officer for the Maryland Occupational Safety and Health program. Other safety and health work history includes risk management consultation for the Maryland State Accident Fund (Worker's Compensation).

His duties currently include overseeing OSHNC Compliance activity and assisting with oversight of the Occupational Safety and Health Program in North Carolina. The OSHNC Division includes consultation, compliance, agricultural and education training and technical assistance programs administered by the NC Department of Labor. All activities within the Division work towards strategic goals associated with reducing workplace fatalities, injuries and illnesses among N.C. employees in the public and private sector.

Kevin currently holds appointments to the Advisory Committee on Construction Safety and Health (ACCSH), by the United States Secretary of Labor and a gubernatorial appointment to the North Carolina Emergency Response Commission (NCERC). He is also the current chair for the Occupational Safety and Health State Plan Association (OSHSPA), which links 27 state plan jurisdictions, federal occupational safety and health jurisdictions and Congress.

Kevin is originally from Maryland and is a graduate of the University of Maryland, College Park campus where he obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial Technology. He currently holds designations as a Certified Safety Professional and a Certified Public Manager. (10/09)
