Martha Salyers, MD, MPH, attended the University of Michigan and the University of California--Berkeley as an undergraduate. She received her MD from Michigan State University College of Human Medicine in 1982 and her MPH in Maternal-Child Health from the University of North Carolina in 1998. She completed the MAHEC Family Practice Residency Program in 1986, where she was Chief Resident. She co-founded Community Family Practice in Asheville in 1989 and practiced there for 8 years. From 1997-2002, she worked at the Buncombe County Health Center, and was Medical Director from 1999-2002. Since April 2002, she has been Team Leader of Public Health Regional Surveillance Team 6 (PHRST 6), the westernmost of North Carolina's seven regional public health teams. PHRST 6's mission is to serve the western 19 counties by preparing and responding to bioterrorism, infectious disease outbreaks, and other public health threats through collaborative planning, education, investigation, and surveillance.
