Gwen Bush

Gwen Bush is a Senior Member of the American Society for Quality and an ASQ Certified Six Sigma Black Belt with experience in manufacturing, services, and health care. She has trained Black Belts, Green Belts, and Yellow Belts and has provided Six Sigma Master Black Belt support for many organizations. She is an RABQSA-registered QMS auditor, an ASQ Certified Manager of Quality and Organizational Excellence, an ASQ Certified Quality Engineer, and an ASQ Certified Quality Auditor. Ms. Bush has over 30 years of experience in applied quality engineering, quality systems auditing, applied mathematics, applied statistics, and training in the Fortune 100 arena. She has been employed as a full-time consultant and instructor since 1997 and has assisted many organizations with quality and environmental management systems registrations as well as “lean” implementation and team problem-solving.

Before going to North Carolina, Gwen worked with Bechtel Corporation in San Francisco, California, doing oil pipeline risk analyses and feasibility studies. At BASF Corporation in North Carolina she worked as a mathematician and statistician in Research Systems Engineering designing plant experiments, assisting in the development of multiple plant databases, and developing mathematical process models in various manufacturing facilities. She spent a total of 23 years at BASF—9 years in Research, 3 years in Engineering, and 11 years working directly in a manufacturing facility.

Gwen was an Examiner/Lead Examiner for the North Carolina State Quality Award and the BASF Quality Award for 3 years and won the “Best Contributed Paper” in Information Systems for SAS Users Group International for developing and presenting customer complaint software.
