NFPA 70E: Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace

Many people in the U.S. are impacted by electrical hazards or incidents that occur from working on or within the limited approach boundary of electrical equipment. In the United States, electricity is a major cause of death and injuries among workers. Electrocution is the fourth leading cause of industrial fatalities. Training in arc flash/blast protection is a relatively new topic that has not been addressed in many of the employer programs, so the hazards are often not addressed. Participants will explore hazards and controls, review standards and learn how to comply, and much more. 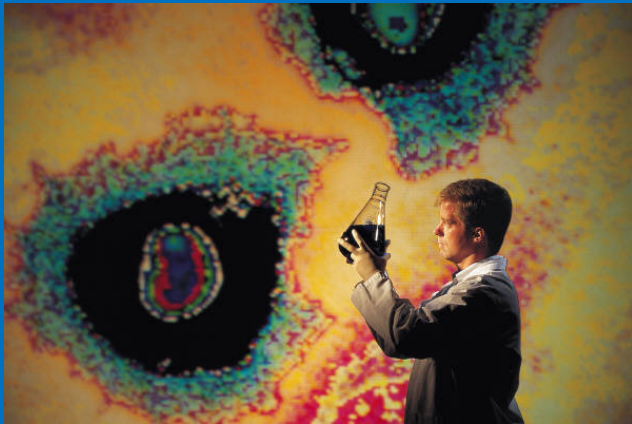
